A forest bioeconomy framework for Canada

- The vision behind the framework is simple yet bold: Canada will be a global leader in the use of forest biomass for advanced bioproducts and innovative solutions. There are multiple sources of clean energy in Canada - hydroelectric, wind, tidal, geothermal, solar, and bio (for electricity, heat, and fuels) —yet biomass is the only renewable source that can substitute the carbon from fossil fuels found in chemicals, plastics and composites.
